

Setting Up External Transfers via Clean Energy Credit Union Online Banking Website


Set Up Step 1:

- Return to Online Banking. Select “External Transfers” from the “Transfers” menu
- Under the “Transfer Funds” tab look for a notification about your account being added
- Click “Verify this”



Setting Up an External Transfer via Clean Energy Credit Union Mobile App

Transferring funds from one account to another is at your fingertips with our mobile app. Once you link your accounts, you'll be able to transfer money from your accounts with just a few taps. If you've already connected your account – scroll down to “Making External Deposits to a Linked Account”.


Set Up Step 1:

Once logged into the app. Select “more” from the menu at the bottom of the screen




Set Up Step 2:

When the more menu loads. Select “External Funds Transfer” from the menu.




Set Up Step 3:

Select “Add a New Account”




Set Up Step 4:

Choose how you'd like to use to verify your account:







Verify Instantly by logging into your external account. (see below)

Verify via micro-deposits deposited into your external account within the next 1-3 business days. (see next page)

If you chose to verify instantly:

You will be prompted to verify your bank account. This includes logging into your external account, authorizing permissions to share your account details and choosing which accounts you'd like to link. Each external account bank process can be slightly different, but the screenshots below walk you through what you can expect.




Once you have completed the steps with your bank, your external account will be connected, and you can begin making transfers into your Clean Energy CU accounts.


If you choose to verify via Micro Deposits

Send Deposits.

You will be asked to Verify your external bank account via micro deposits that will be put into your external account, and you will need to verify the amounts. “Click send me two deposits”





The screen will verify that two deposits are on the way. Check your external bank account over the next two days for deposits from Clean Energy CU. Click “Done”



Once you see the deposits in your external account.


1. Return to the Clean Energy Credit Union app.
2. Click the “more” button and go to “external transfers”.
3. Click the “menu” icon in the top, right and select “accounts”

Under “My Other Account” you will see the information for the external account you are adding. Click “verify”



Enter the deposit amounts:


Verify your account by confirming the amounts of the two deposits made into your external account from Clean Energy Credit Union. Click “Verify”

Making External Deposits to a Linked Account: Mobile App

Once you have linked your external account you can easily transfer money to your Clean Energy Credit Union account.

- Log into the Clean Energy Credit Union mobile app

Making External Deposits to a Linked Account: Desktop

Once you have linked your external account you can easily transfer money to your Clean Energy Credit Union account.

- Log into the Clean Energy Credit Union on your computer
- Select “External Transfers” from the “Transfers” menu
- Execute your external transfer by completing the transfer details.
 - From: Choose the external account you’d like to transfer from
 - To: Choose the Clean Energy Credit Union account you’d like to transfer money to
 - Amount: The amount of money you’d like to transfer into your account
 - Send: The date you’d like to send the dollars
 - Frequency: You can choose a one-time payment or set up auto-transfers based on your desired frequency.



Mobile Check Despots

Deposit checks into your account with ease by using our mobile deposit feature within our mobile app.

- Prepare your Check:
 - Front of Check
 - Make the check payable to yourself.
 - In the memo include the account suffix or loan you would like funds to be applied to
 - Sign the front of your check.
 - Fill out the amount in both numerical and written
 - Fill in the date – Note: The date cannot be post dated

Example:



- Back of Check
 - Sign under the endorsement area
 - If the check has 2 names, both members need to sign and be on the account
 - Write “For mobile deposit only to Clean Energy CU” or “For mobile deposit only and the account number” under your signature




Navigate to the “Check Deposit” Menu

Select “Check Deposit” at bottom of screen




Select Accounts

Tap the account you’d like to transfer funds to and enter the amount.




Take A Photo of the Front of Your Check

- Touch the camera icon
- Hold your phone over the check
- Select “Keep Picture” or retake if you it is not clear



Take A Photo of the Back of Your Check

- Hold your phone over the check
- Match up the endorsement area
- Select “Keep Picture” or retake if you it is not clear



Review and Deposit

- Review that the account and amount are correct
- Tap the “Deposit” button

Your transfer is on its way. Please note:

- The cut off time for same day deposit is before 3pm MT & funds become available at 4pm MT
- Checks will be held if:
 - The member has been with the credit union less than 90 days
 - The member does not have matching funds in their account

Deposit at a Shared Branch

Although our “branchless” business model is an important part of keeping Clean Energy Credit Union’s footprint small, we understand there are times when a branch visit is what’s needed. For those occasions, members have access to thousands of shared branch locations nationwide. [Find a shared branch near you using this locator.](#)

What is co-op shared branching?

Co-op shared branches are credit union locations in which members of other credit unions are welcome to conduct in-person transactions. Hundreds of U.S. credit unions participate in the co-op shared branching network, totaling more than 5,000 branch locations nationwide.

Shared branching also gives credit union members surcharge-free access to almost 30,000 ATMs at credit union branches, convenience stores, and other locations.

When you visit a co-op shared branch location, you're in-person account management options include:

- Deposits and withdrawals
- Transfer of funds between accounts
- Balance inquiries
- Loan payments

Please have your member number ready when you visit the shared branch.

There is no fee for shared branch transactions.

ATM Network

Your Clean Energy Credit Union debit card provides free cash back at the point of sale and free ATM withdrawals from any of 32,000+ MoneyPass® locations in the U.S. and any of 2.1 million Cirrus locations worldwide.

When you visit a in-network ATM you can:

- Withdrawal cash
- Receive balance inquiries

Deposit at a Participating Coinstar Kiosk

Clean Energy Credit Union checking account users who have a debit card can securely transfer coins and cash directly to your checking account from any participating Coinstar kiosk.



What is Coinstar?

Coinstar is a company that provides a service allowing individuals to exchange loose change, particularly coins, for cash or gift cards. They operate a network of self-service kiosks located in various retail locations, such as supermarkets, where people can pour their coins into the machine and receive a voucher or cash equivalent in return. The kiosk counts the coins and deposits them into your Clean Energy Credit Union account. You can also use these machines to deposit cash.

How it works:

- Once you've located a participating Coinstar location using the [kiosk finder](#). Follow the simple steps below.



Associated Fees:

- Cash Deposit Fee: \$5.95 per deposit
- Coin Deposit Fee: 5% of coin volume

- Once you have sent the Incoming Wire Transfer form to your financial institution, email info@cleanenergycu.org to get us know to expect your wire transfer. Please include your name, the date you sent the form and the transfer amount.

Transaction Limits

- External Transfer (mobile & desktop)
 - Transaction Limit:
 - \$2,500 per day
 - Can be increased up to \$6,000 upon request.
 - \$15,000 per month

- Mobile Check Deposit
 - Transaction Limit: \$5,000 per day
 - \$225.00 same day
 - \$5300.00 next day
 - Can be increased to custom amount upon request.

- Shared Branches
 - Transaction Limits:
 - Withdrawal Limit: \$1,000 per day
 - Check Withdrawal Limit: \$2,500 per day
 - No limits on deposits.

- ATM Network
 - Deposits cannot be made via ATM
 - Withdrawal Limit: \$400

- Coinstar
 - Transaction Limits:
 - Up to \$1,000.00 per card in a single day
 - Up to \$2,500.00 per card in a 3-day period
 - Up to \$3,000.00 per card in a 7-day period
 - Up to \$5,000.00 per card in a 30-day period
 - Up to \$1,000.00 per transaction
